



New Albion Medical Centre Fee Structure

New Albion Medical Centre is now a mixed billing practice as of 3rd April 2023.

Consultation fees are payable at the time of consultation with a Debit or Credit card (NO CASH).

Payments will be electronically transmitted to Medicare, and the Medicare rebate will be directly deposited into your account within 24–48 hours.

* Pensioners only: To continue bulk billing **pensioners**, New Albion Medical Centre will charge a \$50 Annual Practice out of pocket fee which will NOT incur a Medicare rebate and will reset on 1st of January 2024. There will be a 30-day grace period following your first appointment from 3rd April 2023 onwards.

Phone Consultations

We charge the same fee for phone consultations as for in-person consultations, because they require the same amount of the doctor's time. We always aim for patients to receive the same level of care and value from all their appointments, whether they are in-person or in the convenience of their homes via phone.

Annual Practice out of pocket fee for pension card holders

To continue bulk billing pensioners, New Albion Medical Centre will charge a \$50 Annual Practice out of pocket fee which will NOT incur a Medicare rebate and will reset on 1st of January 2024.

Treatment Room Fees

Treatment room and procedure fees apply to **ALL** patients. Please check with your GP or reception staff at the time of booking regarding associated costs.

Please note:

- ❖ Consultations will be bulk billed for pension card holders, DVA card holders and patients under 16 years of age (Treatment room fees apply).
- ❖ Workers Compensation/CTP insurance Consultation invoices will be forwarded to the relevant insurance company in accordance with SIRA fees for payment.
- ❖ Pre-employment and Commercial Vehicle - Drivers Licence medical fees do NOT incur a Medicare rebate. Please ask reception for fee information.
- ❖ Travel Consultations do NOT incur a Medicare rebate.

Failure to attend scheduled appointment:

If you are unable to attend your scheduled appointment, please contact us to change your appointment time or cancel. We require 2 hours' notice for cancellations of appointments. A fee of \$20 may be charged for repeated cancellations at short notice or non-attendance of appointments. Please note that this fee is not eligible for the Medicare rebate.

Future bookings will not be accommodated until Non-Attendance fee is paid.

Bulk Billing remains the same for the following services:

- ❖ Health assessments (for eligible patients)
- ❖ GP management plans (care plans)/review of care plans
- ❖ Chronic disease management Nurse Support items
- ❖ Mental health plans/review of mental health plans
- ❖ Administration of prescribed injections
- ❖ Immunisations as per the National Immunisation Schedule
- ❖ COVID-19 and Influenza vaccines
